### **Regional Wastewater Update**

The Regional Wastewater Committee has reviewed and approved the preliminary design study for the regional wastewater system, as presented by Associated Engineering. The request for funding has been submitted to the Province and the Committee is confident about funding approval for this project.

### **Local Wastewater Update**

Grandview Council is working with Norris Beach Council on a draft wastewater bylaw, which would replace the current wastewater bylaw. The proposed draft bylaw has received careful scrutiny from legal counsel and Municipal Affairs.

In addition to the proposed new bylaw, guidelines for the inspection of existing Private Sewage Disposal Systems are being crafted. Associated Engineering was commissioned to create holding tank/septic tank guidelines for residents; this has been completed and is attached.

At the Grandview Council meeting of December 6, 2009 Council resolved to enter into an agreement with the Northeast Pigeon Lake Regional Services Commission (NEPL) and the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10, to enable residents to have their sewage haulers dump at the Mulhurst Lagoon. This will result in recognizable savings to residents for sewage dumping. Further information on this new development will be provided to residents as the information becomes available.
