Part 1: Care and Maintenance of waters wells will be held Tuesday, November 17th at the Lone Ridge Hall. A speaker from Alberta Environment will provide information on landowners' roles in caring for, maintaining and protecting their water wells as well as the investigation process when problems arise.

Part 2: Protection of water wells through regulations, industry practices, geology is planned for January 19, 2010. Speakers, to be confirmed, will speak on regulations in place to protect water wells from industry activity, what goes on underground and what that means to water wells and industry activity.
